Chicago Architecture Foundation Center River Cruise aboard Chicago's First Lady Sets Sail on March 15, Welcomes New Vessel Chicago's Emerald Lady

Official architecture tour announces 2020 schedule departing from the Chicago Riverwalk

CHICAGO, March 6, 2020 – <u>Chicago's First Lady Cruises</u> and the <u>Chicago Architecture Center</u> have announced the 2020 schedule for the official <u>Chicago Architecture Foundation Center (CAFC) River Cruise aboard Chicago's First Lady</u>, the premier way to experience Chicago's world-famous architecture and the only cruise narrated by Chicago Architecture Center docents. The organizations officially launch the 2020 CAFC River Cruise season on Sunday, March 15, continuing their 27-year partnership inspiring Chicagoland residents and visitors with the city's rich architectural history.

Ranked the #1 boat tour in Chicago based on <u>TripAdvisor user reviews</u>, the CAFC River Cruise is the most indepth, authentic architecture river cruise available and is lauded as a "must-do" activity when visiting Chicago. Expertly trained Chicago Architecture Center docents bring their unique perspectives to the tours they lead, sharing their passion for the history and design of more than 50 buildings along the Chicago River and their familiarity with the architects who created them. Tour guests leave the cruise inspired by the city's wide variety of architectural styles including art deco, neoclassicism, mid-century modernism, and postmodernism.

As Chicago's popular Riverwalk continues to grow and evolve, the 90-minute tour – which glides across all three branches of the Chicago River – continues to evolve with it to ensure guests are always learning about the city's continued architectural achievements, including the brand-new Vista Tower, the city's third tallest structure.

Additional CAFC River Cruise offerings include the <u>Capture Chicago Photography Cruise</u>, an early-morning voyage designed with photographers in mind by pausing three times throughout, allowing guests to capture Chicago's finest architectural wonders in all their detailed, dazzling glory. Two <u>Evening River Cruise</u> departures offer guests a serene experience with stunning views of Chicago's architecture bathed in the soft glow of the setting sun.

A portion of proceeds from tickets purchased for the CAFC River Cruise, Capture Chicago Photography Cruise, and Evening River Cruise help support the work of the Chicago Architecture Center, a nonprofit organization whose education programs run year-round, encouraging children, college students, design lovers,

teachers, and teens to learn more about Chicago's architectural significance and to play active roles in creating the city's future.

Beginning this Summer, expanded classic CAFC River Cruise and Evening River Cruise offerings will be made possible by Chicago's First Lady Cruises' newest addition to its custom luxury fleet, Chicago's Emerald Lady. Upon arrival, the vessel will immediately be placed into the rotation to give guests even more unforgettable and enlightening experiences on the Chicago River.

All cruises depart from the southeast corner of Michigan Avenue and Wacker Drive and offer unparalleled, Instagram-worthy photo opportunities. Guests enjoy the experience with comfortable open-air top deck seating, with 360-degree views of Chicago's glittering skyscrapers, and include climate controlled interior salons with large oblong windows, upscale restrooms, and full-service bars.

Guests can complete their experience before or after their cruise at the Chicago Architecture Center, located above the CAFC River Cruise docking area at 111 East Wacker Drive. Permanent and temporary exhibitions on two floors of galleries at the Center unlock secrets behind Chicago and its architectural wonders, with the Chicago City Model Experience and Drake Family Skyscraper Gallery both featuring models of famous buildings along the cruise route. Travelers have the option to purchase a Combination ticket, which includes admission to the Chicago Architecture Center, for an additional \$5, saving them \$7 on Center admission. Guests may visit the Chicago Architecture Center any time within seven days following their cruise. Standalone tickets for the Chicago Architecture Center are \$12 for adults, \$8 for Students (with ID), and free for children under five, with a portion of each ticket sale supporting the Center's mission and education programs.

CAFC River Cruise times vary throughout the season:

- The pre-season schedule lasts from March 15 March 29 and offers cruises on Saturday and Sunday at 10 a.m., 12 p.m., 2 p.m. and 4 p.m.
- The season opening cruises run daily from April 3 April 12 and depart at 10 a.m., 12 p.m., 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. Additional cruises depart Friday Sunday at 11 a.m., 1:00 p.m., 3:00 p.m., and 5:00 p.m.
- Early spring cruises run daily from April 13 April 30 and depart every hour from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Additional cruises depart Thursday Sunday at 4 p.m. and Friday Sunday at 5 p.m.
- Late spring cruises run daily from May 1 May 21 and depart every hour from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
 Additional cruises depart Thursday Sunday at 5 p.m. and Friday Sunday at 9:30 a.m. 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Summer cruises run daily from May 22 Oct. 12 and depart every hour Monday Thursday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and every half hour Friday Sunday from 9:30 a.m. 4:30 p.m. Additional cruises depart at 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, 1:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Monday and Thursday, 4:15 p.m. on Friday and Saturday and 10:15 a.m., 12:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m., and 5 p.m. on Friday Sunday
 - The Capture Chicago Photography Cruise runs from May 23 October 12 and departs every Friday, Saturday and Sunday at 9 a.m.
 - The Evening River Cruise runs nightly from May 22 Oct. 12 at 5:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.
 Additional cruises on Oct. 13 Nov. 1 depart Friday Sunday at 5:30 p.m.
- Early fall cruises run daily from Oct. 13 Nov. 1 and depart at 10 a.m., 12 p.m., 1 p.m., 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. Additional cruises depart Friday Sunday at 11 a.m., 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m., 3:30 p.m., 4 p.m., 5 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.
- Late fall cruises run daily from Nov. 2 Nov. 22 and depart at 10 a.m., 12 p.m., 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. Additional cruises depart Friday Sunday at 11 a.m., 1 p.m., 3 p.m. and 5 p.m.

Boarding Location and Details

The CAFC River Cruise aboard Chicago's First Lady departs from the southeast corner of the Michigan Avenue Bridge at Wacker Drive just three blocks north of Millennium Park. A blue awning marks the entrance to the stairway leading to the Chicago Riverwalk docking area. Discounted self-park is located at 111 East Wacker Drive. Guests with limited mobility may find an ADA ramp located at State Street and Wacker Drive, and limited mobility drop-off directions can be found at CruiseChicago.com.
